I hereby apply for a letter of no objection under **Rule 4(1)** of Notaries Public (Qualifications for Appointment) Rules (Cap. 159 AJ).

The following documents are **enclosed**:-

1. A **cheque** (made payable to “*Hong Kong Society of Notaries*”) in the sum of \$3,000 being the application fee. I acknowledge that the application fee is not refundable whether in whole or in part in any event.
2. A **certified true copy** of the **certificate issued by the Registrar of the High Court** evidencing that the applicant has satisfied the requirement under **Section 40A(1)(a)(i)** of Legal Practitioners Ordinance (Cap. 159) [i.e. the applicant’s name has been on the roll of solicitors continuously for the whole of the period of 7 years immediately before the date of the application for appointment].
3. A **certified true copy** of the **certificate issued by The Law Society of Hong Kong** evidencing that the applicant has satisfied the requirement under **Section 40A(1)(a)(ii)** of Legal Practitioners Ordinance (Cap. 159) [i.e. the applicant has practised as a solicitor for a period or periods in aggregate of not less than 7 years].
4. A **certified true copy** of the **certificate issued by Hong Kong Society of Notaries** under **Rule 8(b)** of Notaries Public (Examinations) Rules (Cap. 159AH) evidencing that the applicant has satisfied the requirement under **Section 40A(1)(a)(iii)** of Legal Practitioners Ordinance (Cap. 159) [i.e. the applicant has passed the examination prescribed by the Council of Hong Kong Society of Notaries within 1 year ending on the date of his application for appointment].
5. A **draft of the affidavit** referred to in **Rule 4(2)(b)** of Notaries Public (Qualifications for Appointment) Rules (Cap. 159AJ) and **Rule 12B(2)(e)** of Admission and Registration Rules (Cap. 159B).
6. A **letter of support** referred to in **Rule 4(2)(c)** of Notaries Public (Qualifications for Appointment) Rules (Cap. 159AJ) to be endorsed by at least 30 signatories, each of whom indicates personal support to the application, and among the signatories –
